



RespirAI Mobile App – Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice is designed to inform users of our Mobile App ("**Users**", "**you**" or "**your**") how RespirAI US Inc. ("**RespirAI**", "**we**", "**us**" or "**our**") handles Personal Information, which may be collected and processed as part of the Mobile App Services we provide.

Any Personal Information you provide to us will be stored in RespirAI's databases and will be used in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Notice and applicable law. You are not legally obligated to provide the Personal Information detailed below. However, without providing such information, we may not be able to provide you with the Mobile App Services, in whole or in part. By continuing to use the Mobile App, you consent to this Privacy Notice and to the collection of Personal Information about you in accordance with it.

The categories of Personal Information described in this Privacy Notice, the purposes of processing, and the categories of third parties to whom we disclose or otherwise transfer Personal Information, reflect our current practices and our practices during the 12 months preceding the "Last Updated" date of this Privacy Notice.

Please read this Privacy Notice carefully and regularly check this page to review any changes we might make.

1. Definitions

"Device" means any mobile device (such as a smartphone or tablet) on which you install and use the Mobile App.

"Mobile App" means RespirAI's mobile application available for download on IOS and Android platforms.

"Mobile App Services" means services provided by RespirAI through the Mobile App, including the collection and display of health and activity data from Third-Party Services, provision of educational content, weather information, and general health-related tracking and reminder features.

"Personal Information" means any information about a User from which that person can be identified.

"Third-Party Services" means wearable health and activity tracking services provided by third parties, including such services provided through devices and sensors manufactured by third parties (such as chest patches and smart watches).

2. The Personal Information That We Collect

When you use our Mobile App, we may collect the following types of Personal Information:

- **Identity Data** includes first name, last name;
- **Physical Characteristics Data** includes age, height, weight, and gender;
- **Health and Wellness Data** includes data collected from Third-Party Services such as: oxygen saturation levels, heart rate and ECG data, movement and step count data, blood pressure, and respiratory-related metrics;
- **Device Data** includes Device ID, device type, operating system, and mobile network information;
- **Technical Data** includes IP address, browser type, time zone setting, and location data derived from your IP address;

- **Geolocation Data** includes GPS-based location information to provide weather forecasts relevant to your area;
- **Usage Data** includes information about how you use the Mobile App, such as when you access the Mobile App, features used, time spent on different screens, and interaction patterns;
- **Medication, Immunization, and Appointment Data** includes information about medications you choose to track, immunizations you've received, appointments you scheduled with physicians and reminder preferences (if you use this feature);
- **Account Data** includes username and password for your Mobile App account;
- **Authorization Data** includes credentials and authorization tokens to access data from Third-Party Services;
- **Communication Data** includes information you provide when you contact us for support through the Mobile App;
- **Content Data** includes any educational articles, weather data, and other content you access or save within the Mobile App.

3. How We Collect Your Personal Information

We use different methods to collect data from and about you, including:

- **Direct interactions.** When you register for the Mobile App, set up your profile, or contact us for support, you may provide us with Identity Data, Physical Characteristics Data, Account Data, and Communication Data; the Mobile App also allows you to enter Medication and Appointment Data;
- **Automated technologies or interactions.** As you use the Mobile App, we automatically collect Device Data, Technical Data, Geolocation Data, and Usage Data;
- **Third-Party Services.** When you authorize the Mobile App to access data from Third-Party Services (such as chest patches and smart watches), we collect Health and Wellness Data from those services through their respective cloud platforms or APIs;
- **Third parties or publicly available sources.** We may receive Technical Data and Usage Data from analytics providers (such as Google Analytics) and advertising partners;

If you provide us with any Personal Information relating to others (such as healthcare providers or caregivers), you must ensure you have permission to do so.

4. How We Use Your Personal Information

We use your Personal Information for the following purposes:

- **To provide the Mobile App Services,** including displaying your health and wellness data, providing educational content, weather information, appointment reminders, immunization tracking, and medication reminders;
- **To enable Third-Party Services integration,** including connecting to and retrieving data from sensors you authorize;

- **To personalize your experience**, including tailoring content, recommendations, and weather information based on your profile and preferences;
- **To respond to your requests or inquiries** and to manage our relationship with you;
- **To improve our Mobile App**, troubleshoot technical issues, and ensure proper operation and user experience;
- **To send service communications**, including important updates, security alerts, and support messages;
- **For analytics and research purposes**, to understand how users interact with the Mobile App and to improve our services;
- **To comply with legal obligations**, including: (a) as required by subpoena, law, or other legal process; (b) to assist law enforcement officials or government enforcement agencies; (c) to protect us from legal action or claims from third parties; or (d) to protect the legal rights, property, or safety of our company, users, employees, and affiliates;
- **For purposes to which you have given your consent** in connection with the processing of your Personal Information;
- **To generate aggregated, anonymized, and/or de-identified data** for any purpose. Such information does not reveal your identity and is not considered Personal Information.

5. **Minors**

To use the Mobile App, you must be at least 18 years of age or older, if otherwise required by the laws of your jurisdiction. We do not knowingly collect Personal Information from individuals under 18 years of age.

If you are a parent or legal guardian and believe that your child may have provided us with their Personal Information, please contact us immediately.

6. **Third Party Services**

The Mobile App integrates with Third-Party Services. When you authorize such connections the privacy policy of the third party offering the Third Party Service will apply to their collection and use of your data. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of these third parties, and we recommend reviewing the privacy policies of any Third-Party Services you connect to the Mobile App.

7. **Selling and Sharing Personal Information with Third Parties.**

We may share Personal Information with third party service providers that provide services to us in connection with the purposes listed in above (such as providers of cloud services, IT support, and analytics and crash reporting/performance monitoring providers). These providers may process Personal Information on our behalf and, in some cases, may collect information directly from your Device via SDKs integrated into the Mobile App.

We may also share Personal Information related to you with legal and regulatory authorities, to the extent required by applicable law; our professional advisors (e.g. lawyers, accountants) to the extent necessary for the provision of their services to us in accordance with the purposes listed above; third parties to whom we may choose to sell, transfer, or merge our business (or parts thereof) or our assets, provided that such third parties have committed themselves to protecting your Personal Information in accordance with the principles set forth in this Privacy Notice; and potential purchasers or investors during the evaluation of such transactions.

8. International Transfers

We may transfer Personal Information to countries outside of the country in which the User resides, that do not provide the same level of data protection as the country in which the User resides.

9. Data Security

We have put in place security measures to prevent Personal Information from accidental or unlawful loss, use, alteration or disclosure.

Nevertheless, we cannot guarantee against the loss or misuse of Personal Information or secure data transmission over the internet because of its nature.

10. Data Retention

We retain your Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes we collected it for, including for legal or reporting requirements.

In order to determine the appropriate retention period for Personal Information, we consider the following criteria: the volume, nature, and sensitivity of the Personal Information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of Personal Information, the purposes for which we collect and process Personal Information, the timeframe during which we may require such Personal Information in connection with potential litigation, and applicable legal requirements.

11. Your Rights

Certain privacy laws, including the California Consumer Protection Act (CCPA) and other US states consumer privacy acts, provide users with rights related to their Personal Information. To the extent that such laws apply to your Personal Information, you may have one or more of the following rights:

- **Right to Know:** Request information about the Personal Information we have collected about you in the past 12 months, including categories collected, sources, purposes, and third parties with whom shared.
- **Right to Access:** Request a copy of the specific pieces of Personal Information we hold about you.
- **Right to Delete:** Request deletion of your Personal Information, subject to certain exceptions.
- **Right to Correct:** Request correction of inaccurate incorrect, incomplete, or inaccurate Personal Information, or Personal Information that is not up to date.
- **Right to Opt-Out of Sale/Sharing:** We do NOT sell your Personal Information or share it for cross-context behavioral advertising. We have not done so in the past 12 months.
- **Right to Non-Discrimination:** You have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment for exercising the above-mentioned rights.

If you are a resident of Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Maryland, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Nevada, Oregon, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, or Virginia, you may have similar privacy rights under your state's privacy laws. If we make material changes, we will notify you by posting an updated version on the Mobile App and updating the "Last Updated" date. Your continued use of the Mobile App after any changes constitutes acceptance of the updated Privacy Notice.
